A legal agreement in which a person borrows money to buy property and pays back the money over a period of years.



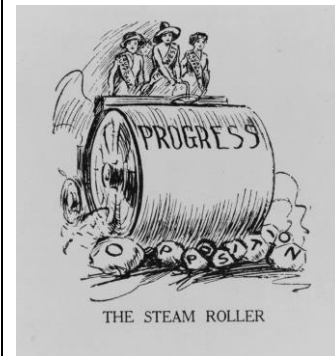







Exclusive possession or control.
